Conditions of Entry

1. Entries must be works of, or demonstrate a relevance to **Mt Kembla coal - from pit to ship**. Coal and its journey through local landscape, flora, fauna, seascape, industry, rail, miners, workers, farms, community, port etc.
2. Entries must be the original, unaided work of the entrant
3. Entries must be two dimensional and the size of the work shall not exceed 100cm X 100cm
4. Entries may be of any medium i.e., watercolour, oil, acrylic, pastel, ink, etc or combination
5. Entries must be suitably framed, with cord and hooks ready to hang
6. **A non-refundable entry fee of \$30 must accompany each entry form payable to Mt Kembla Mining Heritage Inc**
7. **Each artwork must be accompanied by the entry form below, and delivered to Di Hittmann, 269 Cordeaux Road, Mt Kembla NSW on Tuesday 30th July between the hours of 9am – 7pm only**
8. No entries may be removed during the exhibition
9. Name, address, email and phone number must be clearly marked on the back of the work
10. All works must be for sale by auction at a post-exhibition function in September/October 2008
11. A commission of 30% on all sales up to the artist's reserve price will be paid to Mt Kembla Mining Heritage Inc (MKMH Inc) and a commission of 70% of the amount over and above the artist's reserve price, reached at the auction will be paid to MKMH Inc.
12. The reserve price of the work must be clearly indicated on the entry form
13. The organisers reserve the right to select works for display in an exhibition associated with the event or to promote the Mt Kembla Art Prize and Mt Kembla Mining Heritage Festival via any medium including brochures, website and print material of any type
14. There will be no refund of entry fees for works not selected for hanging
15. Insurance is the full responsibility of the entrant. The organisers will exercise all care but will accept no liability or responsibility for loss or damage of the works while held by the organisers or in transit
16. Delivery and collection of works will be the full responsibility of the entrant. Works not selected for auction at the post-exhibition event may be collected between the hours of **10am & 7pm ONLY on Wednesday 6th August 2008 from 269 Cordeaux Road, Mt Kembla**. Works not collected by this date will be disposed of at the discretion of the organisers without liability to the organisers
17. Entrants shall allow their work to be reproduced for publicity purposes and waive any copyright claims in this instance
18. The judges decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into
19. The winning work becomes the property of Mt Kembla Mining Heritage Inc (The prize includes the artist's price for the work)
